**"We Are All Missionary Disciples": A Conversation on
Mission to the Poor**

At this conversation, we are delighted to have Br. Vijaya Sagar Gundiga, AA and Fr. John Cervini share with us their experiences of ministering to the poor.

Br. Sagar comes to us from India. He is currently an Assumptionist pursuing his M.Div. at Saint John's Seminary. He will be sharing with us his ministry this past summer with migrants in Paris.

Fr. John Cervini is currently a resident at the Assumptionist Center. He is a priest for 48 years with the Diocese of Rockville Centre, L.I., NY. Having received a D.Min. from Princeton Theological Seminary, Fr. John was the former director of pastoral formation at the major seminary for Brooklyn and Rockville Centre, and had also spent 17 years ministering in the Dominican Republic. He will be sharing with us his experience of organizing Christian communities in the Dominican Republic as a reflection of liberation theology in practice.
